Please come out and join the fun! For the men, Guys Night Out is once a month. In addition to great golf, the feast prepared by Chef Kent is truly a treat. Please join the next Guys Night Out on January 17th, with golf set up as a par 3 course beginning at 3:00pm and dinner at 5:30pm.

Many of you have met **Rasmita Taylert**, our new Assistant Golf Professional. If not, please stop by the shop and say "hello" to her. We also have a young intern who will be working the cart barn and the golf shop, **Robbie Nieman**. If you haven't had the pleasure of meeting these individuals, please take the time to do so. I think you will find both of them to be great additions to the Avila family.



Our winter cultural practices and the new techniques we use to improve our efficiency on the golf course during the cold months are the topics we'll review this issue.

Most of you are aware of our venting process, which is a simple process in which tiny holes are poked in the greens to allow for gas exchange, water movement in the soil profile, and compaction relief. In the past, we used a standard cross tine to poke a hole and allow for gas exchange. Even if done perfectly, there would still be bumps for a few days. While doing research, I came across the ninja tine that produces a smaller hole that can be rolled out allowing play to resume as normal while still achieving the same goal.

An important practice in the winter months is the flushing of the greens. As the winter tends to be on the drier side, we rely on irrigation water. Typical irrigation water in Florida has a high level of sodium and bicarbs. In trace amounts, this does very little to the grass, but over time, they build in the soil and they tie up good nutrients. Periodically, usually in conjunction with a venting, we try to flush out the sodium and bicarbs with a soil product that is designed for their removal. Once applied, we let it sit in the soil and then turn on the water for a couple of hours to flush them out, leaving a more functional soil profile that is better for play.

Throughout the coming year, I will post some of my favorite drills on Clubster and in some of our Newsletters. The Putting Performance Drill that I assigned the most in 2018 was the 8 Foot Drill. Give this drill a try and put it into your practice routine.

8 FOOT DRILL (50% of 8 footers are holed on the PGA Tour):

Hit a total of 6 different putts in an 8 ft circle around a hole. If you make 3 out of 6 (50%), your score is Even. If you make 4 out of 6, your score is -1. If you make 2 out of 6, your score is + 1, etc. This is a great drill to do at anytime and it only takes a few minutes. I especially like to do this drill before I play a round of golf, as it puts me in a good routine and a good feel for the green speeds.
